ADOPTION OF 2019 CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL PERFORMANCE EVALUATION REPORT



The CAPER is an annual evaluation of the city's progress and implementation of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) programs and activities for the 2019 program year and long-term goals and priorities set forth in the 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan.

Interested persons are invited to submit written comments prior to and may provide verbal comments at the public hearing. **Written comments may be submitted to Stephanie Cotter, City of Citrus Heights, Housing and Grants Division, 6360 Fountain Square Drive, Citrus Heights, CA 95621.** Comments and questions received through Monday, March 30 will be included in the city's final 2019 CAPER.
