


Citrus Heights Sunday Funday Survey Summary

1. Had you heard about the Creek Corridor Trail Project before seeing this survey?





3. What do you believe are the primary concerns with development of creek/utility corridor trails?






4. If creek/utility corridor trails were created, about how often do you think that you would use them?






5. If creek/utility corridor trails were created, how do you think you and other members of your household would use them?





6. Do you currently visit other trails in Citrus Heights or trails within the greater Sacramento region?






7. What do you believe are the benefits of creek/utility corridor trails?






8. In which age bracket are you?






9. How many children under 18 live in your household?

The City of Citrus Heights is undertaking a study to determine the feasibility of establishing a multi-use trail system within the City's 26 miles of creek corridors. The study will identify existing conditions, constraints, opportunities, alignment options, phasing options, and cost estimates for a multi-use trail available to walkers, joggers, wheelchair users, and other non-motorized uses.

This survey asks for your views about the potential development of multi-use trails in the City's creek corridors and the SMUD utility corridor illustrated on the map below. Hearing from the community is an important part of the process to making sure the trail works for Citrus Heights. The survey is one component of the City's extensive public engagement process that also includes a Trail Advisory Group (TAG) and community meetings.
